N A R R A T I V E 1	Topic Original Report	<p>M.O.: By throwing a rock through a window to gain access to business and by going through offices there.</p> <p>Lt WARNER Sir,</p> <p>On 11/3/08, at 0530 Hrs, cars were detailed to PHIL VEDDA & SONS PRINTING, 12000 Berea, on a report the business was broken into.</p> <p>Upon our arrival, officers spoke to VIC/ JAMES VEDDA, who advised on 10/31/08, at 1800 Hrs, he closed the business and it was fine. On today's date at 0520 Hrs, he arrived at work and started to prepare for the day. VEDDA advised he went into the lunch room and found that there was a window that was broken out. VEDDA went into his office and noticed that it had been gone through. VEDDA called LPD. Officer HAYES and I checked the interior of the building and no one was found in the business. In checking the business, it was found that another office had also been gone through. In the offices the cabinet doors and desk drawers were found open. The offices were on the South side of the business.</p> <p>In checking the point of entry, it is located on the Southwestern corner of the building. There is a glass door and windows at that location. The lower window was broken out, which is 30" by 35". The point of entry is hard to see from the street, due to trees and bushes in the way. There were marks on the glass door that indicates the rock was thrown against it four times, but it did not break. There is a security camera by that door that watches a picnic table and another door. The rock was found laying on the floor in the lunch room. The rock that was used to break the window was made of concrete and was about 12" x 6" in size, similar to the rocks located behind the business. The rocks were excess cement left over from the construction of the business. Inv PICKENS arrived to process the scene, but found nothing of evidentially value.</p> <p>VEDDA advised that there are three other security cameras in the building. VEDDA advised when his computer technician comes in he will have him check to see if the cameras saw the suspect. If so VEDDA will have a copy of the video made and he will contact LPD. VEDDA advised he did not observe anything that was missing, but he will contact LPD, if he finds out something is. VEDDA advised that he has no suspects, but he desires prosecution if any are developed.</p>
