N A R R A T I V E 1	Topic Original Report
	M.O.: By entering an apartment while the tenant is not there and taking the listed items without the owner's consent
	SGT Spaetzel, Sir, Detailed to 16201 Madison #4 on the report of an apartment being broken into. Arrived and was met by VIC/JOHN HUNTER as he was exiting apartment #3.

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HUNTER stated that someone had entered his apartment between 1400 and 1410hrs. HUNTER left for the store to buy cigarettes at that time. HUNTER does not know who, but believes that the person pried the rear door lock in order to gain access. No evidence of forced entry was found and there is no reason to believe that the rear door is the point of entry. It should be noted that the door knob and strike plate appear to have been recently replaced and only show minimal signs of wear and tear. HUNTER advised that the two listed cell phones (silver Alltell and Sprint, flip-style), \$153.00 cash, a Direct Express SSI banking card (), and four keys (main doors, main doors, bedroom, mailbox) were taken from a table in the room next to his kitchen. HUNTER stated that he cancelled the card prior to notifying LPD.

HUNTER changed his story multiple times during my contact with him. At one point, the only items missing were the money and the bank card and the rear door had been "kicked in" and damaged. HUNTER also insisted that he had locked all the doors when he left the apartment. Eventually, HUNTER listed all of the above items as missing. HUNTER changed his statement about locking the doors after reporting his keys were stolen, as he would not have been able to enter the apartment without keys if the doors were locked. HUNTER also conceded that the apartment was entered by means other than kicking the door down since the door and door jamb have no signs of damage.

HUNTER stated that he hid his money inside of an open utility bill located amidst an assortment of open mail envelopes. HUNTER did not explain why he did this. HUNTER noted that he is the only one who knew about the money, but that the rest of the mail did not appear to be gone through. HUNTER could not explain why he left his phone, keys, money, and bank card at home if he was going to the store to purchase goods, nor could he explain his need for two activated cell phones. Near the end of our contact, HUNTER noticed a newspaper on the small table where the listed items were taken from. HUNTER theorized that whoever entered the apartment left this Sunday edition of the Plain Dealer on the table. HUNTER is not certain, but does not believe that the paper belongs to him. HUNTER feels that someone came in and "got comfortable" during the 10 minutes in which he was gone. An Investigator was not requested.

HUNTER was advised of the low solvability of this incident and will prosecute if an arrest is made.
