N A R R A T I V E 1	Topic	Original Report
<p>M.O.:By breaking out a window on the rear door of the house, then entering the house and taking coins and liquor without permission.</p> <p>On 11/7/08, at 1359 hours, I responded to 1461 Newman Ave. on report of a burglary at that location. On arrival, I spoke with VIC/ANITA MORENO. MORENO said that someone entered her house between the listed times and stole the listed items.</p> <p>MORENO stated that she left for work and locked the house at about 0800 hours. She said that when she came home from work at 1330 hours, her front door was unlocked. She said she thought that was odd, and she noticed some lights on in the house that she knew were off when she left. MORENO said that she entered her kitchen and found glass on the floor, in the area of the back door. MORENO explained that she then discovered that a pane of glass was broken from her back door window. She said that the door was locked at that time.</p> <p>MORENO said she began to examine the apartment, because she felt someone likely broke in. She said that all she could determine was missing was several rolls of change from her bedroom dresser, and a bottle of liquor from her refrigerator. MORENO said she then called LPD.</p> <p>Inv. Walling and I examined the scene. The glass from the door in the kitchen was scattered across the floor of the kitchen. The window pane measured 12" by 8". Inv. Walling processed the scene but found nothing of evidentiary value.</p> <p>MORENO had no suspect in the incident. MORENO understood the solvability. She said she was mainly concerned with making a record of the incident. I asked her to contact LPD if anything else was missing, or if she had any additional information.</p>
