Topic Original Report

On 11/8/08, at 0549 Hrs, Officers responded to 1302 Sloane regarding a male that had overdosed on Heroin. When I arrived on scene I observed a male, later identified as SUB/ARNOLD PENNEY, slumped over the wheel of his vehicle, which was parked behind 1302 Sloane. LFD had arrived on scene just prior to my arrival. They indicated the male was breathing and had a pulse, but was unconscious. They transported the male to the Lakewood ER.

I spoke with COM/TWILA RICHARDS and learned the following:

RICHARDS indicated she lives in West Virginia with PENNEY. They were in Lakewood for the last two nights visiting her daughter, OIV/TWILAJA TORRES. RICHARDS stated she is a recovering Heroin addict. She and PENNEY split up three years ago when she stopped using, but had recently gotten back together because she thought he had stopped. RICHARDS and PENNEY were supposed to be heading back to West Virginia this morning when PENNEY went out to the car around 0500 to fix the headlights on the vehicle. At approximately 0545 Hrs, TORRES noticed the vehicle was still running, and pointed it out to RICHARDS. When RICHARDS went out to the vehicle she found PENNEY unresponsive, slumped over in the drivers wheel. RICHARDS found a hypodermic needle on the front passenger seat. She indicated she bent the needle and put it into a pop can. RICHARDS could not recall what was done with the can. RICHARDS stated she was unable to locate any Heroin.

Sgt. Eschweiler was speaking with TORRES inside the residence when she observed a Diet Pepsi can in the garbage can. TORRES stated she doesn't drink Diet Pepsi and found it unusual. When we looked in the can, we observed a hypodermic needle inside. The needle was removed from the can. Inv. Deucher located two wax papers with residue in the drivers side door compartment. Both the needle and wax papers were confiscated and tagged and secured in the property room.

I responded to the ER, along with Inv. Deucher and Sgt. Eschweiler. PENNEY stated he did not know what happened, and indicated he did not recall purchasing or doing any drugs.
