Topic

11-12-08, Detailed to St. Charles on report that a juvenile was assaulted on his way home from school. Upon arrival, spoke with COM/ who stated that he was walking home from Lakewood City Academy today, and when he was at the intersection of Marlowe/ Franklin, he was "attacked".

He stated that a black male, wearing a black ski mask, black t-shirt, black jeans and gloves came out from behind a large dumpster and punched him. He stated that the t-shirt had "aeropostle" written on the front and the jeans had "DC" on the legs. He stated that the male was approx 5-08 and muscular.

stated that the male came out from behind a dumpster and punched him in the stomach and when he bent over he was pushed over. The male then went through 's pockets and asked him if he had anything. According to when the male didn't find anything in the pockets he then hit him in the head with a tree branch and knocked him out. When he came to he walked home and told his mother what had happened.

I told that there was no dumpster in that area, he then said that it must have been a tree. continued to change his story approx four times. When I told him that I did not believe his story, his mother also agreed with me. He did not have any visible injuries and I asked him how it was possible, if he was hit in the head with a tree branch hard enough to knock him unconscious? He stated that he had his hood on. I advised him that through the altercation, it was unlikely that his hood would stay on and that he would not have any red marks or lumps on his head.

Due to the inconsistencies in his different versions of what had happened I asked how he would do if given a lie detector test and he stated that he didn't know. He was advised that making an untrue police report was a crime. He maintained he was telling the truth. He was advised that he could be asked to come in and speak with a detective at a later date.

I then spoke to his mother outside and advised her that I didn't think her son was being truthful. She agreed but then stated that her son "never lies". She stated that he is usually home from by 1355 hrs and did not come home until approx 1440 hrs. She stated that if he doesn't come home right away, he would only go his friend's house and he always calls her. It should be noted that he did have fresh mud and grass stain on both knees of his jeans.

It should further be noted that in the area where stated this happened, during the time frame given, there are generally numerous other people out and about but we did not get any reports of a fight, disturbance, etc.
